

# Saint Joseph Lay Carmelite Community #2415 Rochester, Minnesota Province of the Most Pure Heart of Mary September 2025 Newsletter


## Dear Lay Carmelites,

Let us recognize Blessed Mary of Jesus (1560-1640) born in 1560 at Tartanedo (Spain). Maria López de Rivas took the Discalced Carmelite habit at Toledo in 1577 and made her profession the following year. She spent the rest of her life serving God in that Carmel except for a brief period in 1585 when she helped with a foundation at Cuerva. She died at Toledo on September 13, 1640.

Saint Teresa of Jesus thought extremely highly of her and intervened when the Toledo community were going to dismiss her on account of ill health. St. Teresa said that if they would not admit Sr. Maria to Profession, then she must be sent to the Carmel of Avila where Teresa herself would receive her gladly. She was a great contemplative, intensely devoted to our Lord, and often drawing inspiration from the liturgy.
